- But do we consider, contemplate why The Holy Trinity commissioned Him to come?

THE BEGINNING:

- Gen. 2:7 Man is Formed. (to fashion like a potter)
- Gen. 2:15-16 God gives man the first commands.
- Gen. 2:17 the warning for disobeying God's commands.
- Gen. 3:6, 7 the disobedience.
- Gen. 3:19 the judgement of disobedience.
- 3:15 The promise of redemption.

MAN'S CONDITION DUE TO DISOBEDIANCE, THE FALL.

- Ecc. 7:20 For *there is* not a just man on earth who does good And does not sin.
- Rom. 5:12, Therefore, just as through one man sin entered the world, and death through sin, and thus death spread to all men, because all sinned
- **Rom. 3:10-18, 23**
- **Eph. 2:1-3, 12.**
- 1 Jn. 5:19 we know that we are of God, and the whole world lies *under the sway of* the wicked one.

12 REASONS FROM THE MOUTH OF JESUS WHY HE CAME. (12 days of Christmas)

- To glorify, to manifest the Father. Jn. 12:27, 28 For this purpose I came, Father glorify Thy name. Jn. 17:4, I have glorified thee on the earth:
- **Heb. 10:7-9**, To obey the Father.,
 - Jn. 4:34. My food is to do the will of Him who sent Me, and to finish His work.
- Mt. 5:17 to fulfill the law.
- Mt. 1:26, Call His name Jesus for He shall save His people from their sin..
- 1 Tim. 1:15, This *is* a faithful saying and worthy of all acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners

- Lk. 19:10, for the Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost..
- Mk. 10:45, I came not to be served. But to give My life a ransom for many.
- Jn. 10:10, That His sheep may have life.
- Lk. 5:32 I have not come to call *the* righteous, but sinners, to repentance."
- Jn. 1:29, The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world..
- Lk. 4:18, 19. To preach the good news and see it manifested.
- Heb. 2:14, 15 To render the devil powerless.
- 1 Jn. 3:8, For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil.

These 12 are just some of the reasons He came. These and the many more that I did not mention, to all of them Jesus testified, "IT IS FINISHED."

- Jn. 17:4 I have finished the work which You have given Me to do. & Jn. 19:30
- Have I received the "I have comes" Have they been fulfilled in my life?
- Am I the fulfillment of His statements?
- One of the Fathers love gifts. One of the "those whom You have given Me." Jn. 17
- Am I part of the Reward due to the Lamb?
- Isa 53: 11, He shall see of the travail of his soul, and shall be satisfied
